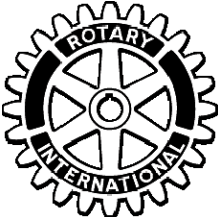

Spreading the Word!

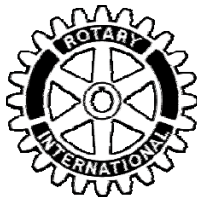
