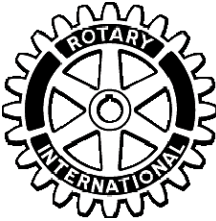

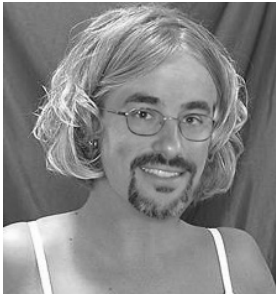

Auction Donors Give It Up!

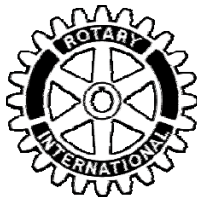
