Terry's Drink of the Week

Forget about your martini bar. The latest rage in cocktails, according to local mixologists, is the Mojito. Born in Cuba in the early 1900's, the Mojito is new to most people and is a very refreshing summer drink (you have until the end of Autumn to catch up, though). The original recipe grinds mint in the glass but this tastes bitter and leaves junk in your teeth. Here's a variation that is outstanding and easy to make:

Prepare a mint syrup:

1 cup of sugar 1 cup of water 1.5 cups of fresh mint leaves Boil several minutes until the leaves look like mushy spinach then strain syrup into a bottle.

Now mix the drink:

2 oz light rum
1 oz mint syrup
1 lime's juice
Add ice and fill with soda water. Top with fresh mint leaves and a slice of the lime rind.
