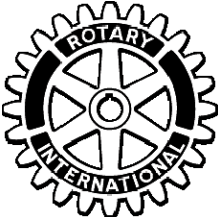

## Special Auction Edition!

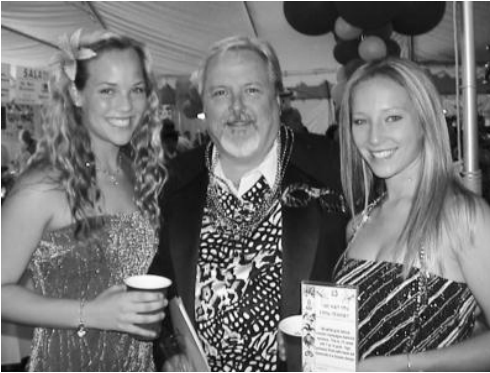

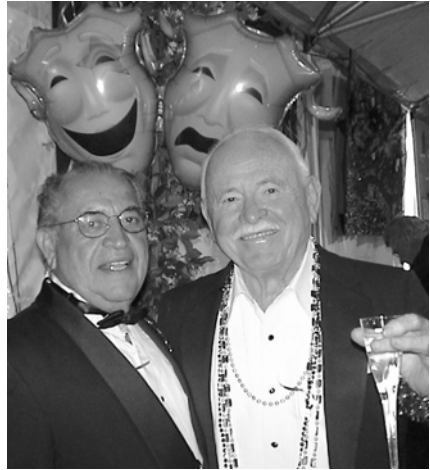

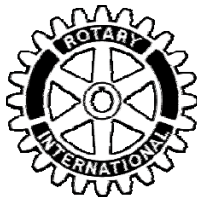
